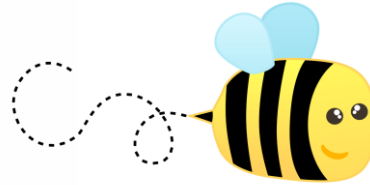

## Important Information

Friendly reminder to check your child's bin in their cubby. We are noticing that many children have empty bins. Children should have an extra set of clothing (shirt, shorts/pants, socks, underwear) that are the correct sizes and weather appropriate. Children that are potty training should have several sets of clothing in case of an accident. Please take a moment to look in your child's cubby to make sure it has the appropriate items in them.

Reminder: Splash Days begin June 21<sup>st</sup>. All children participating will need to have a bathing suit, towel, water shoes or an extra pair of shoes that can get wet and a bag to put everything in. Children must have all items in order to participate. Extra clothing in bins cannot be used as swimwear. They must have 2 pairs of shoes – one for splash time and one to be worn in the classroom.

As summer begins, please remember that we do have a 10am no drop off period. Children must arrive by 10am. There is a charge for late drop offs. If staffing changes have been made, the classroom may not be able to accommodate them. Please make sure that you call in advance to arrange any day that your child may be late due to a doctors, dentist or other appointment. These must be prearranged with a director.

We recommend leaving a small light weight jacket or sweatshirt in your child's cubby for mornings that may be chilly.

## Summer Field Trip Packet

Our Summer Program Packet is attached for those in our summer program (back two rooms). All classrooms will be able to participate in the games, activities, weekly themes, splash days, Kona Ice days, etc. However; our summer program kids also have field trips. This field trip packet is for all of the field trips and is included in your parent newsletter June envelope. There are three permission slips. Please DO NOT leave on the front desk. We must mark each child as they pay. Please see field trip letter for more details regarding bus transportation and space available.

Permission slips and money (cash only) are due at the same time with the exact amount of change. This cannot be added in with your tuition as this is a separate event and paid directly to the companies. Your field trip cost covers the cost of the bus, bus driver and our destination of where we are going. Movies include the movie, popcorn and drink. For-Mar includes activities throughout the nature preserve including the tree house as well as lunch at the pavilion before we head back.

Please remember to talk with your child regarding acceptable behavior while outside of Brandi's Place. This includes but is not limited to:

Being respectful, using indoor voices, staying with chaperone assigned to them, appropriate bus/passenger safety, no running and bathrooms are not a place to play – only tell your chaperone if you have to go.

Any child that does not abide by the rules listed they will not be able to attend another field trip without a parent as their chaperone. In extreme situations, the parents will be called to pick up their child's at field trip site as stated on the permission slip. Any child who has had an action card within the last 30 days will need private transportation with a parent chaperone for the trip. All accounts must be in good standing (no previous balances) in order to attend field trips.

Children do not have to attend the field trips. There will be a classroom with staffing and activities available for those not attending.

We hope that this helps with field trip questions. Please refer to your letter, permission slips or see the front desk if you have any further questions.

### **Sunscreen Forms**

At this time, all sunscreen forms should be back to teachers with a bottle of sunscreen with your child's name clearly marked on it. Sunscreen must be **new and unopened**. If you chose not to have sunscreen applied to your child, you must return the form signed with a note stating that "sunscreen is not needed." Sunscreen cannot be applied without a signed form. Both form and sunscreen must be turned in at the same time.

## Kona Ice Days

Kona Ice days are coming up! Kona Ice visits every 2 weeks and brings a sweet treat on a hot day. They will bring their fun truck playing fun music. Children will get to make their own "flavored ice" using the choices that are on the side of the truck. Some flavors include Lemon-Lime-A-Licious (Lemon/Lime), Blue Raspberry, Wild Watermelon, Strawberry Treasure, Ninja Cherry, Pina Colada (Pineapple & Coconut), Island Rush (blue tropical punch) and Monster Mango. There are many different flavors but these are the main flavors that they generally bring with them.

Kona Ice cost is \$3 per person. This is an additional cost that is not part of tuition. Brandi's Place only arranges for them to come as a fun thing during the summer months. However, there will be NO COST during Transportation Day or Family/Community Picnic. Brandi's Place covers the cost for these two events for everyone. This is an optional activity for children. We are very discreet when taking children to get their Kona Ice. Children do eat outside when they get this and do not bring it back to the classroom.

Only cash (exact change) can be accepted for this event as well due to the money going directly to the Kona Ice company. Money can be given to the front desk. We will have an envelope that has your child's name on it and the date that you are paying for. Please see a director if you have any questions. We are looking forward to a fun fill summer!

## Father's Day Celebration "Pops with Pop"

Our annual "pops with pop" is scheduled for Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup> from 3 to 4pm. Come in and have popsicles with your child anytime between 3 and 4pm. You can enjoy time in the classroom or play on the playground with them.

Due to our latchkey children getting out of school early this year (June 7<sup>th</sup>) we are moving up our Father's Day Celebration by one week. The children have been working hard on their projects for dad.

We understand that not everyone can make it during these times. Please feel free to send someone special in your place if you would like. No child will be left out of the fun, all children will be able to have a popsicle and enjoy the fun time during this time if parents cannot make it.

## Menus

There are 4 menu's that rotate each month. Once we finish week #4, the menu will go back to menu #1. Please make sure that your child has extra food in their cubby should they not like what is being served or cannot have what is being served due to allergies. Some examples that parents leave are: Easy Mac, can of soup, can or ravioli, etc. These are quick and easy to warm up on days when needed.

Menus are subject to change depending upon supplier stock. There are times that we may have to substitute a vegetable or fruit for a different one if needed or change a day in menu. Please make sure that your child has items in their cubby each day should they need them. It is important to notify the teacher that these items are in their cubby so they can be looking for them when needed.
